Lister's aim was the prevention of disease. The object of his antiseptic method, as it was called, was to stop germs from getting into the body. The cure of a disease was a difficult problem, for here the germs were already inside the body. Certainly, they could be killed by the same antiseptic method, but it was soon found that a chemical that destroyed germs also destroyed the cells of the body. Injecting carbolic acid into the blood was tried and quickly abandoned, for it did more harm than good. To kill all the germs a dose would have to be so strong that it would kill the patient too. Carbolic acid and all the other known antiseptic did the more damage to the leucocytes than to the germs. The problem was to find something that would attack only the germs; and so help, not destroy the fighting leucocytes.
